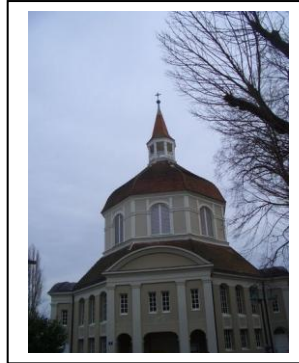

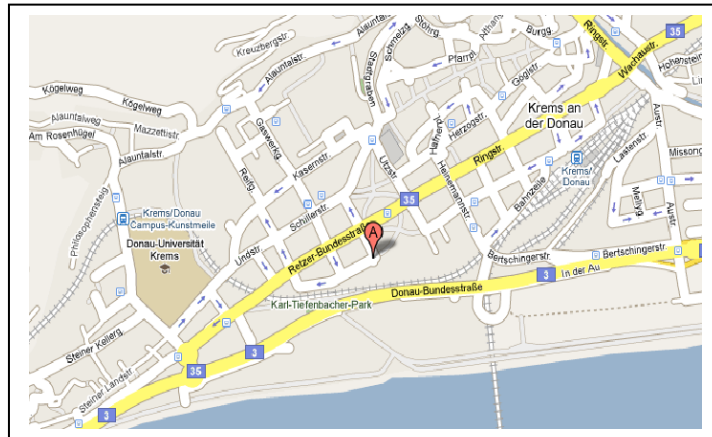

Interior: bright, light-flooded cupola room, benches arranged around the far encroached altar table, eight plain columns with Doric capitals, narrow gallery with organ, basic/artless contents

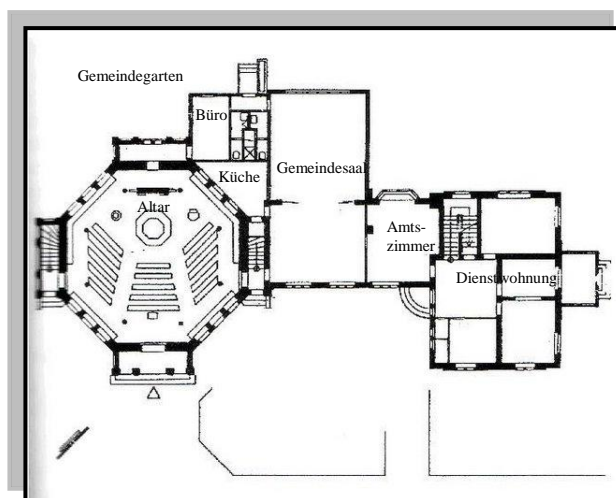
